Troop 941 is a large but friendly troop based in Pleasanton California, with members from most of the Pleasanton schools and the surrounding area

We use the model of the BSA Scouts program as Lord Baden Powell intended, structured around the patrol method. We are a full uniform troop that is truly boy led.

Troop 941 Welcomes New Scouts!

Webelos who join our troop in the early spring are put into specially created "new boy patrols" led by Troop Guides (experienced older scouts). New boy patrols are dissolved in the Fall, at which point the scouts are integrated into regular patrols.

Outings

Troop 941 is an active troop, generally camping at least once a month. 2019 camp outings have included winter camping at Lake Tahoe and in the Gold Country, Mountain biking in Marin, exploring waterfalls and rocky caves at Yosemite in the spring, then white water rafting to kick off summer. We participated in Camporee for the Twin Valley District at Rancho Los Mochos. Summer Camp was at Wente Scout Reservation again in our normal spot at 12:00 High. This fall, we backpacked into the Trinity Alps, went Rock Climbing at Bear Valley and chilled out at Shaver Lake near Kings Canyon.

Our ad-hoc High Adventure Crew had the Ultimate Adventure at Camp Makualla in Oregon.
